

The 2012 acquisitive *Tidal: City of Devonport Art Award* once again highlights some of the most innovative and thought-provoking art work produced within Australia. The Devonport Regional Gallery is proud to host this national award, which provides a platform for contemporary artists to consider and speculate on the myriad implications of 'tidal'.

Tidal is a theme that has currency in our changing world of rising sea levels, soil corrosion, depletion of fish supplies and pollution of our rivers and seas – to name but a few related issues. Yet, it also speaks of personal memories and interactions with the sea and coastal regions. Importantly, it is a universal theme that artists have been exploring and portraying in varied ways for a very long time.

Judges Humphrey Clegg, Assistant Curator of Australian Art at the National Gallery of Victoria (NGV) and Craig Judd, Independent Curator and Arts Writer, have selected 27 artists' work for inclusion in the 2012 finalists' exhibition. Ranging across photomedia, works on paper, prints, painting and video, the selected artists


have approached 'tidal' from either personal, political or environmental angles to produce work that provokes inquiry and enlivens the imagination.

Tidal would not be possible without the financial support of Devonport City Council and the Friends of the Devonport Regional Gallery committee who have, for the second consecutive Tidal raised \$5,000 toward the \$15,000 Award. This year, for the first time, the Peoples' Choice Award is sponsored by Collins Real Estate and our gratitude is extended to Stacy Sheehan for her enthusiasm for the arts in our region.

The Devonport Regional Gallery and Devonport City Council recognise the importance of *Tidal* and its contribution to the cultural life of the city of Devonport, and acknowledge all artists who entered the Award. 


Launch Day 2012 Pigment print on Canson Baryta paper 104 x 136 cm




















Sight Seeing 14 - Marion Bay 2012 Acrylic on watercolour paper 38 x 76 cm


